ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Seminars #5

On Feb 8, Prof. Haibo ZHANG from Anesthesia, Medicine and Physiology of the University of Toronto delivered a seminar titled "Infection and Immunity in ARDS: Novel Therapeutic Targets".

His research focuses on the mechanisms and therapy of acute lung injury and sepsis. He demonstrated that given the heterogeneity of acute respiratory distress syndrome (ARDS), identification of ARDS endotypes may facilitate the therapeutic interventions in the cohorts of patients who are most likely to benefit. Alternatively, the novel therapeutics that target multiple mechanisms of injury, maintain or augment host defenses to pathogens, and facilitate the lung repair process are promising.

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
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STUDENT ACTIVITIES
